While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order — just talk.

- See the sun breaking through the clouds? The world was dark with sin — and Jesus is the light.
 - The Bible calls Him “the dawn from on high” — like a sunrise after a long, dark night.
 - Light always beats darkness. Darkness can’t win.
 - When Jesus was born, it was like the sun coming up on the whole world.
 - He still shines on us in His Word — that’s how we see the way to go.
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Ask: What does light do to darkness?

Answer: Chases it away.

When the picture is done, pray together: “Jesus, Light of the world, shine on us.”
