

The Fourth Sunday in Advent

While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order — just talk.

- See that heavy sack of stones? Those are our sins — every wrong thing.
 - Look how bent-over the man is. Sin is too heavy for us to carry.
 - Now look at Jesus — He's lifting it right off him. We could never lift it. He can.
 - He carried our sins all the way to the cross.
 - When the pastor says "your sins are forgiven," that sack is gone.
 - That's why Christmas is coming: God became a man to carry what we couldn't.
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Ask: Who carries your sins?

Answer: Jesus.

When the picture is done, pray together: "Thank You, Jesus, for carrying my sins."
