

The Circumcision and Name of Jesus

- See Joseph holding the baby? On the eighth day, they gave Him His name: Jesus.
- Jesus means “the Lord saves.” His name tells us what He came to do.
- He was placed under the Law — circumcised like every Jewish boy — even though He made the Law.
- He did it for us, so He could keep the Law perfectly in our place.
- There’s no other name that saves. We pray, baptize, and believe in the name of Jesus.

Ask: What does the name Jesus mean?

“The Lord saves.”

When the picture is done, pray together: “Jesus, Your name is our salvation.”
