The Fifth Sunday after the Epiphany

While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order. Just talk.

- See the tall wheat? See the weeds growing right next to it? In this story, Jesus says the field is the world.
- A man planted good wheat seed, but an enemy came at night and planted weeds among the wheat.
- The servants wanted to pull up the weeds right away, but the master said no. Pulling the weeds might hurt the wheat too.
- The master said, “Let them both grow together until the harvest.”
- At harvest time, the weeds are gathered and burned, and the wheat is brought into the barn.
- Jesus is the one who planted the good seed. We are His wheat, and one day He will bring us home to heaven.

Ask: What happens to the wheat at the harvest?

Answer: It is brought into the barn.

When the picture is done, pray the Epiphany 5 collect together.
