For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order. Just talk.

- See the farmer throwing seed? In this story, the seed is God's Word, and the ground is our hearts.
- Some seed fell on the path, and the birds ate it. Some hearts hear God's Word and let the devil steal it from them.
- Some seed fell on rocks. It sprouted fast but dried up, because it had no roots. Some people believe for a while, then stop.
- Some seed fell among thorns and got choked. Cares and riches can choke God's Word in our hearts.
- Some seed fell on good soil and grew a huge crop, a hundred times what was planted.
- Ask God to make your heart good soil, so His Word grows in you and bears fruit.

Ask: What is the seed in the story?

Answer: The word of God.
