The Fourth Sunday in Lent

While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order. Just talk.

- See the basket in Jesus' hands? It holds five little loaves and two fish. A boy shared his lunch with Jesus.
- About five thousand men sat down on the grass, and Jesus gave thanks. Then He gave the food to everyone, and all ate as much as they wanted.
- Everyone ate until they were full. Then the disciples gathered twelve baskets of leftovers. Jesus wastes nothing. His gifts are more than enough.
- The people said, This is the Prophet we have waited for so long. They wanted to make Jesus king by force.
- Jesus did not come to be a king with soldiers and swords. He is a King who gives His life for us. He went up the mountain alone to pray.
- Jesus still feeds us today. In His Word and in His Supper, He gives us Himself.

Ask: What did the little boy share?

Answer: Five loaves and two fish.

When the picture is done, pray the Lent 4 collect together.
