While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order. Just talk.

- See the lamb on Jesus' shoulders? Jesus is the Good Shepherd. He carries His sheep when they are lost or tired.
- I am the Good Shepherd, said Jesus. The Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.
- A hired man runs away when the wolf comes. He does not own the sheep. Jesus stays, because the sheep are His.
- I know My sheep, and My sheep know Me, said Jesus. He knows your name. You know His voice.
- Jesus has other sheep too, from every land. He is bringing them home. One flock, one Shepherd.
- The Good Shepherd died for His sheep and rose again. Now He watches over us every day.

Ask: What does the Good Shepherd do for His sheep?

Answer: He lays down His life for them.
