The Eleventh Sunday after Trinity

While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order. Just talk.

- See the man kneeling with his head down? He is a tax collector. Everyone thinks he is a sinner.
- He beats his chest and prays, 'God, be merciful to me, a sinner!'
- See the man standing behind him? He is a Pharisee. He thanks God that he is not like other men.
- Jesus says the tax collector went home right with God, and the Pharisee did not.
- Why? The Pharisee trusted in himself. The tax collector trusted in God's mercy.
- Jesus says, 'Everyone who lifts himself up will be brought low, but the one who bows down will be lifted up.'

Ask: Which prayer did God love?

Answer: 'God, be merciful to me, a sinner!'

When the picture is done, pray the Trinity 11 collect together.
