While You Color · Late Elementary · For the Parent

For the parent: say these as your child colors. No need to go in order. Just talk.

- Peter asks Jesus, 'How many times must I forgive my brother? Seven times?' Jesus answers, 'Seventy-seven times.'
- See the king and the kneeling servant? The servant owes more money than he could ever pay back.
- He begs for mercy, and the king forgives the whole debt. Every penny.
- Then that servant grabs a friend who owes him only a little and throws him into prison.
- The king hears of it and is angry. 'I forgave you everything,' he says. 'Should you not forgive too?'
- Jesus says, 'So will My heavenly Father do to you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart.'

Ask: How many times did Jesus say to forgive?

Answer: Seventy-seven times.
