

SEATED IN THE TEMPLE

Daniel supplies the blueprint, Paul names the man, and the Lutheran Confessions name the office. All three place the enemy **inside** the household of God rather than outside it.

A TIME, TIMES, AND HALF A TIME · THE WHOLE AGE OF THE CHURCH · DANIEL 7:25; 12:7

175–164 BC

Antiochus IV desecrates the temple. The type appears. **Dan 8**

THE FIRST ADVENT

The Word takes flesh; the last hour begins. **1 Jn 2:18**

FIFTH CENTURY AD

Rome collapses. The restrainer is taken away. **2 Thess 2:6–7**

THE CHURCH AGE

The mystery works in the open, inside the temple of God. **2 Thess 2:4**

THE PAROUSIA

Undone by the breath of his mouth. **2 Thess 2:8**

III DANIEL'S BLUEPRINT: TWO LITTLE HORNS

Daniel 7 and 8 are not the same horn

DANIEL 8 · THE TYPE

Antiochus IV Epiphanes

A Seleucid king, 175–164 BC. One reign, one city, one people. He defiles the temple, outlaws the Torah by force of arms, and dies: a rehearsal and a warning.

DANIEL 7 · THE ANTITYPE

The Little Horn

Rising from the fourth beast, this horn outlasts empires. It wars on the saints for the whole age, and its weapon is the mouth: great words against the Most High.

"TO CHANGE TIMES AND LAW"

"He will speak words against the Most High, and will wear down the holy ones of the Most High, and will intend to change appointed times and Law." **Daniel 7:25**

The claim is liturgical before it is military: reset the calendar of worship, revise the Word, move the ground on which faith stands. The deadliest persecution takes nobody's life; it changes the terms of salvation.

THE VERDICT IS ALREADY ENTERED

"The court will sit, and they will take away his dominion, to be consumed and destroyed to the end." **Daniel 7:26**

A season is granted, never a verdict. Scripture fixes the term of the war before it narrates the war, which is why this vision was given to a people already under occupation.

IV PAUL: THE MAN OF LAWLESSNESS

2 Thessalonians 2:1–12

"...the one opposing and exalting himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he seats himself in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God." **2 Thessalonians 2:4**

WHICH TEMPLE?

Not a rebuilt house of stone in Jerusalem. Paul's temple of God is the congregation itself. **1 Cor 3:16–17** Luther read it the same way: God's temple names holy Christendom, not a pile of stones. The threat is an insider, robed and credentialed.

THE RESTRAINER

Something holds him back, and the Thessalonians already knew what. **2 Thess 2:6–7** The oldest reading names the Roman order. While its law stood, lawlessness stayed a mystery; Rome fell, and what had worked in the dark began working in daylight.

HIS END

He arrives with counterfeit signs and wonders, permitted for a season. **2 Thess 2:9** His destruction takes no army: the Lord Jesus kills him **with the breath of his mouth**. The breath is the Word, preached. **2 Thess 2:8**

V THE LUTHERAN VERDICT: AN OFFICE, NOT A MAN

FOUR MARKS THE CONFESSIONS APPLY

- 1 He rules inside the Church**, enthroned among Christians rather than reigning as a pagan emperor outside. **Tr 39; 2 Thess 2:4**
- 2 He makes himself the door**. Salvation is declared impossible apart from his power and rules, which cancels justification by faith alone. **SA II.iv.10–14**
- 3 He forbids marriage**. Enforced clerical celibacy is read against Daniel's king, who disregards the desire of women. **Ap XXIII; Dan 11:37**
- 4 He honors a god of fortresses**: gold and temporal power gathered by the sale of rites God never commanded. **Ap XXIV; Dan 11:38**

"...the pope is the real Antichrist, who has raised himself over and set himself against Christ, for the pope will not permit Christians to be saved except by his own power, which amounts to nothing since it is neither established nor commanded by God."

Smalcald Articles II.iv.10–11

AN OFFICE

The charge falls on an office claiming supreme authority over the conscience, never on the soul of a baptized man. Popes die; the claim outlives them.

AND STILL THE MANY

The spirit of antichrist works wherever the incarnation is denied and wherever works are stirred into grace. Rome holds no monopoly. **1 Jn 4:3**

WHY SAY IT AT ALL?

The article stands as a warning to the Church rather than an insult to a neighbor. Naming where the Gospel is obscured is how a confession protects consciences, and the same test falls on every pulpit, this one included.

WITH THE BREATH OF HIS MOUTH · 2 THESS 2:8

The Church answers this enemy with no weapon of her own. She preaches, baptizes, absolves, and communes, and no counterfeit survives the sound of the genuine article. The Lamb who was slain has won already, the Ancient of Days has convened his court, and the horn keeps only the season it was given.
